

Only the following referees¹ who have known and can positively identify/verify the customer are deemed Acceptable Referees:

- Barrister, Solicitor and Notary Public under the official stamp;²
- Commissioner for Oath;²
- Justice of Peace under the official stamp;²
- Medical Practitioners or Doctors including Eye and Dental Surgeons under the official stamp;
- District Nurses with Official Hospital Stamps or Health Centre stamps
- Police Officers with ID Numbers and Official Police Station stamp
- District Officers, District Advisory Officers and District Commissioners under the official stamp;
- Social Community Leaders - Non Profit making Social Service Organisations under Official Stamp of Organisation for example Friends of Fiji, Soqosoqo Vakamarama, YWCA, YMCA.
- Social Welfare Officers with Official Stamp
- Post Masters of Post Offices with Official Stamp
- Permanent BSP Life employees and BSP Life Insurance District Sales Managers.
- District Advisory Councilors under Official stamp
- Provincial Officers or Administrators Under Official Provincial Office stamp
- Roko Tui or Assistant Roko Tui under Official Ministry of Fijian Affairs, Provincial or District Administration Office stamp
- Fiji Sugar Corporation Sector Office Representative under FSC stamp (applicable for Sugar Cane Farmers or Labourers only)
- Letter of Introduction by current employer, school, tertiary institute on official letterhead and stamp should bear name, date of birth, occupation and residential address of customer.
- Town, City Mayors, Administrator, Chief Executive Officer under Town or City Council Official stamp
- Religious Leaders with relevant stamps for example Church Pastor, Priest, Malvi, Maulana and Pundits;
- BSP staff under official branch stamp
- Any Other Referee as may be appointed from time to time by the Business FTR Compliance Manager as delegated by FTR Regulations
